The IGH is located on the Arnaud de Villeneuve biomedical campus, which is linked to the University Hospitals and the Faculty of Medicine. The campus also includes the Institute of Functional Genomics and the Center for Structural Biochemistry, with a research area of more than 15,000 m². This excellent scientific environment is supported by BioCampus, a service provider fully equipped with a wide range of state-of-the-art facilities, including genomics, proteomics, medium throughput screening, imaging, animal facilities and high-end instrumentation for structural biology and biophysics. Finally, the campus includes the Genopolys building facilities, which provides opportunities for organizing meetings, teaching, training and outreach activities to the public.

Candidates will be selected on the basis of international scientific excellence, following the LIBRA recruitment guidelines for inclusive, transparent and unbiased recruitment processes. Special attention will be given to innovative, high-risk projects. The selected group leader will receive laboratory space and support from the IGH, as well as assistance in preparing grant applications to French and European agencies.
